Some of the features of these systems are:

- **See Live Video:** Check in on your home anytime, anywhere with crystal clear video.
- **Get instant Alerts:** Receive notifications the moment motion is detected, so you can take action immediately.
- **Hear and Speak:** Some systems let you speak directly to the visitors through your camera. This is perfect for unwanted guests or to remind your kids to lock up!

Video monitoring can also allow you to check in on a loved one when you're not home. We've seen members use these cameras for checking in on their kids when they're not there to being able to watch over a loved one who may live far away but needs someone to check-in.
